Located at the base of the Sintra hills this Rocky Roquemore designed golf course is an enjoyable challenge for all levels of golfer.

A Robert Trent Jones designed course routed through numerous Mediterranean pines and with great views to the Atlantic Ocean and the Sintra Hills. Quinta da Marinha hosted a European Senior Tour event in 2002 and a European Challenge Tour tournament in 2007.

12.20: Transfer to <u>Belas Clube de Campo</u>

13.00 – 17.30: 18 holes at Belas



Situated approximately 30 minutes north east of Cascais, Belas is an undulating heathland style course with great views to the Sintra hills. In 2011, Belas became the first course in Iberia to be certified by GEO (Golf Environment Organisation) and later that year hosted the European Senior Tour Portugal Open. (Buggy recommended).

19.30: Transfer to *Furnas do Guincho* for dinner (not included in the package)
